Types of Units: Shared rooms or private rooms, all of which have shared bathrooms.

Size of Facility: 12 residents.

Ratio of Staff to Residents: During the day, the ratio is 1 staff member to 6 residents. Overnight, the, the ratio is 1 staff member (who is awake) to 12 residents. The administrator, who is a registered nurse, is regularly at the home and on call 24/7.

Meals and Dining Options: 3 home-cooked, delicious and nutritious meals (and snacks) are included in the monthly cost. Menus are customized to residents' preferences, and special diets can be accommodated.

Amenities: At Assisted Living on Broadway, there's a secure outdoor area with a covered porch, pavilion, and walking area. The common area inside the home includes a large, open, and inviting space where residents can participate in activities, visit, take in the sights and smells of the kitchen, and dine together family style. The residents' rooms have high ceilings and are bright. Rooms can be furnished, at no extra cost.

Regularly Scheduled Activities: Activities are scheduled daily, and residents are encouraged to participate. Specialized activities for dementia are offered, across the five domains of functioning: Cognitive Stimulation, Life Skills, Motor Movement and Fitness, Sensory Stimulation, and Socialization. Musicians and other entertainers come to Assisted Living on Broadway on a regular basis.

On-Site Services: There are geriatric, primary care physicians who regularly visit to treat residents at the home. It's not required that residents receive care from these doctors, but it's an effective and convenient option for residents and families. Other optional services for residents include: RN foot care, dental hygiene and dental services, optometry, and a hair and nail stylist.

Pet Policies: No, residents can't have pets at Assisted Living on Broadway, but pets are allowed to visit.

Smoking: Yes, smoking is permitted at Assisted Living on Broadway.

Year Built/Opened: Assisted Living on Broadway opened in 2014.

Lease Terms The lease term at Assisted Living on Broadway is month-to-month. The facility or the resident can terminate the least at any point, with 30 days notice.
