THE GARDENS AT ST. ELIZABETH

Types of Units: In Independent Living at The Gardens at St. Elizabeth, there are 1-bedroom and 2-bedroom apartments, all of which have full kitchens. In Assisted Living at The Gardens at St. Elizabeth, there are studio, efficiency, and 1-bedroom apartments. The efficiencies and 1-bedrooms have kitchenettes.

Size Of Facility: In Independent Living, there are 132 apartments, and Assisted Living has 56 apartments. The Gardens at St. Elizabeth has a total of 188 units.

Ratio of Care Staff to Residents: In Assisted Living, during the day and evening, the ratio is 1 staff member to 7-8 residents. Overnight, the ratio is 1 staff member to 11-12 residents.

Meals and Dining Options: At The Gardens at St. Elizabeth, Independent Living includes one meal per day, with the option of purchasing more meals. In Assisted Living, three meals per day and snacks are included. There are three dining options at The Gardens: a main dining room, a 14th floor restaurant and pub, and a coffee bar bistro.

Amenities: The Gardens at St. Elizabeth is a faith-based community with a 122-year-old chapel, weekly inter-denominational services, and daily Catholic mass. At The Gardens, there's also a fitness studio, game room, movie theater, salon and spa, walking paths, sun porch, two libraries, and a community garden and English garden.

Regularly Scheduled Activities: Throughout the month, there are outings and activities including an aromatherapy class, health talks, a walking club that circles Sloan's Lake and Friday afternoon entertainment.

Individual Transportation: Individual car transportation can be scheduled daily.

Group Transportation: There's scheduled group transportation daily for trips to the bank, shopping, scenic drives, and outings.

On-Site Services: At The Garden at St. Elizabeth, doctors make house calls as needed. There's also a foot clinic run by a nurse, a blood pressure clinic, and a hearing aid clinic. On-site, there's a hair salon and spa, and a dentist and dental hygienist also come in on a regular basis.

Pet Policies: Yes, dogs, cats, and birds are allowed in Independent Living and Assisted Living at The Gardens at St. Elizabeth. Dogs must be leash-trained and weigh less than 40 pounds.

Smoking: No, The Gardens at St. Elizabeth is a non-smoking community.

Year Built/Opened: The chapel at The Gardens at St. Elizabeth was built in 1897, and The Gardens has been providing senior care since 1954. Assisted Living opened in 1974, and Independent Living opened in 1987. In 2019, more than \$10 million was spent remodeling The Gardens at St. Elizabeth.

Lease Terms: In Independent Living and Assisted Living at The Gardens at St. Elizabeth, the lease terms are month-to-month. The lease may be terminated at any point, with 30 days notice.

Age Restrictions: At The Gardens, residents must be over the age of 55.

Accepts Medicaid: No, Medicaid isn't accepted.
